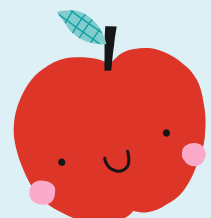

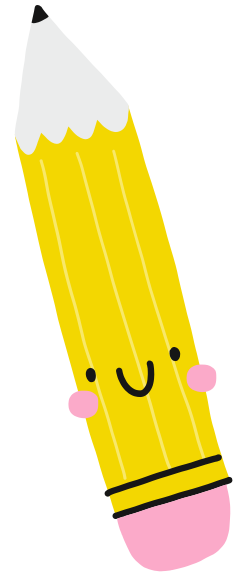
Lannergrams

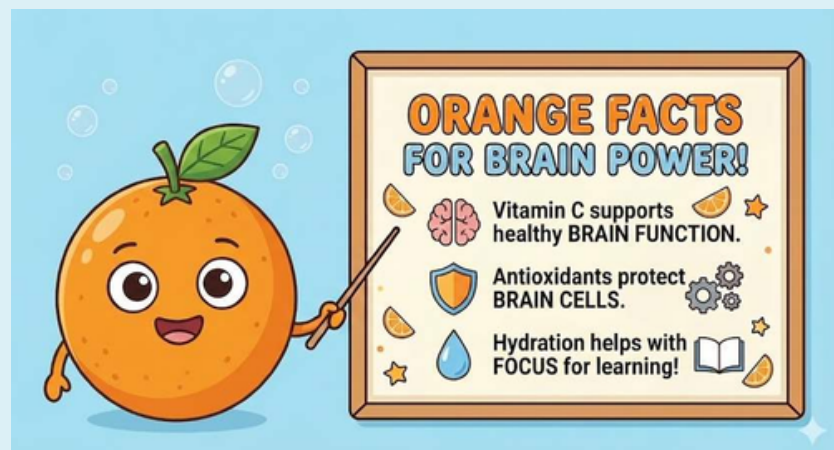

Each week we will share some healthy snack ideas that KS2 children might like to bring in for their mid morning break.

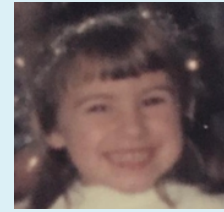


Guess who...

- Tell us an interesting fact about you?

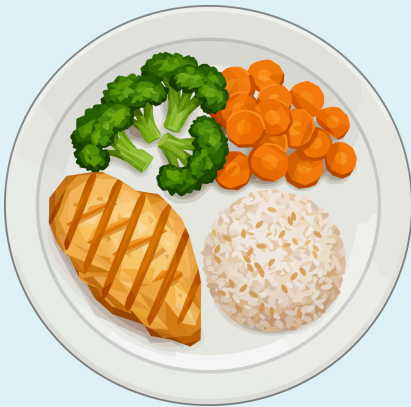
I was once a catwalk model when I was three years old.
