- What is your favourite food?

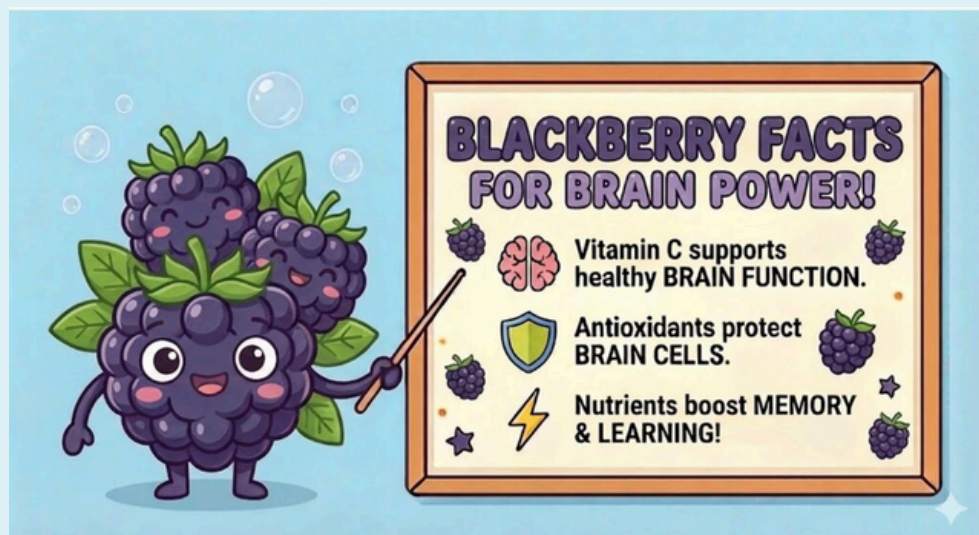
This would have to be a Cheese Board and my Mum's Christmas Dinner!!

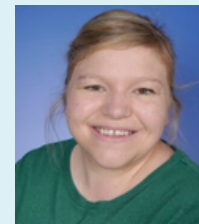


Guess who...
