I'm on my back from year 4 camp, so a very short one from me.

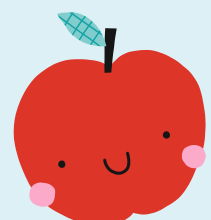
The children were amazing!! Made lifelong memories and I can honestly say, there has not been a cross word said between them:)

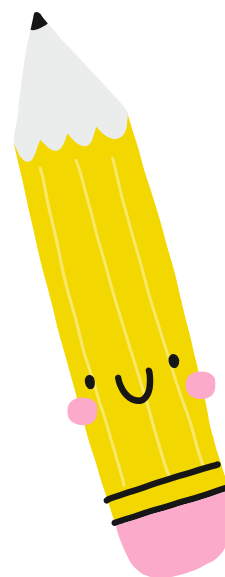
Lannergrams

Well done to everyone who received a Lannergram this week.

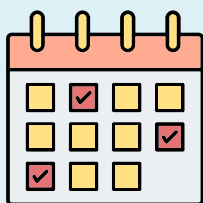
