Dear Parents/Carers,

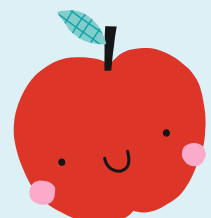
Just a really quick one from me today as I need to get back up the field for our final day of activities.

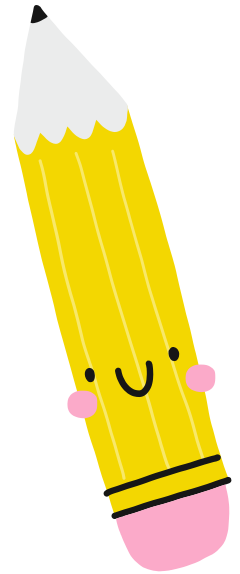

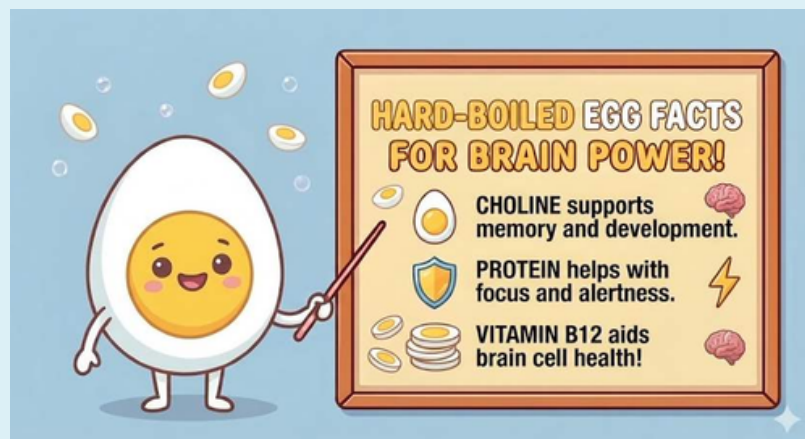


## Dates for the diary
