

# Lanner School KS1 Pupil Acceptable Use Policy 2022-23

## Computer and Online Safety Rules

I understand that I must use the school computer systems in a responsible way to ensure that there is no risk to my safety or to the safety and security of other people or the computer systems.

### This is how we stay safe when we use computers:

- I will wash my hands before and after using any equipment.
- I will ask a teacher or suitable adult if I want to use the computers / tablets.
- I will only use activities that a teacher or suitable adult has told or allowed me to use.
- I will take care of the computer and other equipment.
- I will ask for help from a teacher or suitable adult if I am not sure what to do or if I think I have done something wrong.
- I will tell a teacher or suitable adult if I see something that upsets me on the screen.
- I know that if I break the rules I might not be allowed to use a computer / tablet.
