







# YEAR 2 GEOGRAPHY – ANTARCTICA

<p><b>Continent</b> -A continent is a large solid area of land.</p>	<p>Antarctica is the driest place on Earth and the world’s largest desert. It is also the coldest and windiest place on Earth. <p><b>North Pole</b> -The North Pole is the point that is farthest north on the planet Earth.</p>	<p>Penguins can survive in Antarctica because they have a thick layer of blubber under their fur to keep them warm, they have flippers to make them strong swimmers and a long beak to help them to catch fish.</p>	
<p><b>South Pole</b> - The South Pole is the point that is farthest south on the planet Earth.</p>	<p>Antarctica and the Sahara are both deserts. They are both very dry places on Earth.</p>	
<p><b>Equator</b> - The imaginary circle around the earth that is halfway between the North and South Poles.</p>	<p>Under the snow and ice in Antarctica and the South Pole is land, not ocean (which is why Antarctica is a continent) whereas under the ice at the Arctic region and North Pole is an ocean of water – the Arctic Ocean.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Other recommended reads</p>
