## Library News!

Following a pupil survey which we recently conducted in school, we have made the decision to refresh our school library with the aim of being able to provide a better space for the children to enjoy on a more regular basis, as well as providing greater access to books for children to take home to enjoy reading for pleasure, in addition to their school 'reading books'. New school librarians have been appointed and are helping to make decisions and re-organise the library. Whilst we are working on this, we wanted to find a way to provide more books for your children to enjoy. Therefore, this week your child should have brought home a letter about 'Borrow Box'. This is an online library which is run by the Cornwall Library Service and is accessed via an app on a mobile device. Children can borrow e-books and e-audio books to download and read, or listen to, on a tablet or phone. This service is absolutely free and provides access to a great range of popular books that you would usually find in a bookshop or your local library, including recently published books along with lots of old favourites. Your child has been issued with an individual membership number to use with Borrow Box. This can be found on the letter along with instructions on how to access Borrow Box. If you have any questions, please contact Mrs Pulley in school.
