The blue whale is the largest known animal to ever have lived.

Far bigger than any dinosaur, an adult blue whale can grow to a massive 30m long and weigh more than 180,000kg - that's about the same as 30 Tyrannosaurus Rex! Its tongue alone can weigh the same as an elephant and its heart can weigh the same as a car.
