Please check your eligibility for Home to School Travel Assistance before naming your preferences (www.cornwall.gov.uk/schooltransport).

If you require any additional support, please speak to the school office, or contact the School Admissions Team (Contact the Schools Admissions Team - Cornwall Council or 0300 1234 101).

Please note that parents/carers of children with an EHC Plan do not need to apply – they will be contacted by the Statutory SEN Service in the autumn term.
