#### Letter from the Head



Dear Parents/Carers,

I hope you are well.

as we have them, we will start getting them out to you - hopefully, next week. Questions and answers around parking, drop off, seat numbers and collection on the night will

follow over the coming weeks.

As always, we have a few other treats planned for the children over the Christmas period. I have said this to you all before - but your children work incredibly hard

here at Lanner. We have really high expectations of them, so it is important that they are rewarded. Of course we celebrate these things every day in

school, and weekly in assemblies, but it is also nice to put special events and days on for them. We love them coming to Lanner and hope they love coming to Lanner too.
