<p>Gospel – considered to be ‘good news’ by Christian people. There are 4 gospels in the Bible: Matthew, Mark, Luke and John. They tell the stories of Jesus.</p>	<p>The message given in the Parable of the Two Builders is that Christians should build their lives on strong foundations and belief in God. Jesus asked others to follow his teachings.</p>	
<p>Parable – a story with a moral or spiritual message, as told by Jesus in the gospels.</p>	<p>The story of The Sermon on the Mount tells Christians that Jesus taught his followers how to behave towards God and towards others.</p>	
<p>Sermon – a talk or a lesson about a religious or moral topic.</p>	<p>The Bible tells Christians that Jesus said the two greatest commandments are to love God and to love your neighbour (Matthew 22:36–40).</p>	
<p>Reconciliation – restoring peace or friendliness following forgiveness.</p>	<p>The message in the story of The Centurion’s Servant, is that anyone can come to Jesus, regardless of their religious belief.</p>	<h3>Agreed Syllabus End Points</h3>
<p>Holocaust – destruction or slaughter on a massive scale; the systematic mass slaughter of European Jews during WWII.</p>	<p>“Forgiveness is not forgetting; it’s actually remembering – remembering and not using your right to hit back. It’s a second chance for a new beginning.” Desmond Tutu</p>	<p>Make sense of belief:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Identify features of Gospel texts. • Taking account of the context, suggest meanings of Gospel texts studied, and compare their own ideas with ways in which Christians interpret biblical texts
<p>Apartheid – meaning ‘apartness’. The segregation of black people from white people in South Africa from 1948 until 1993.</p>	<p>Christians pray to communicate with God. 4 key reasons for prayer are to offer praise to God, to make confessions, to ask for help, to give thanks.</p>	<p>Understand the impact:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Make clear connections between Gospel texts, Jesus’ ‘good news’, and how Christians live in the Christian community and in their individual lives
<p>Prayer – religious belief in communication with God to praise, confess sins, ask for help or to give thanks.</p>	<p>Christians consider Jesus as a role model or a guide for living their lives, considering ‘What would Jesus do?’ (WWJD).</p> 	<p>Make connections:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Make connections between Christian teachings and the issues, problems & opportunities in the world today, including their own lives. • Articulate their own responses to the issues studied, recognising different points of view.
